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## CUSTOM OPTIONS

Our products standardly come in black. Occasionally someone wants a different color to match the seat or the paint or to get away from black. We offer 4 shades of brown and white in a heavy leather. We can also get other colors. These are the standard choices.

Distressed Brown

Long Straps are where the straps extend across the top of the lid and hang long. You can pull the straps up and put jackets or chaps on top. When they are not in use they tuck under the bag and do not dangle or hang loose. In the alphabet soup description of our saddlebag part number the Long Straps are LS.



Chrome Studs are the little chrome dots as seen in the picture. We use S to mean Studs in our alphabet soup description of a saddlebag.



Conchos are the round chrome medallions on the center of the bag. It has the tassel coming out of the middle. We use C in our alphabet soup description of a saddlebag part numbers.



Studs and Conchos can be added to most bags. Here is a picture that shows how both will look. In our alphabet soup part numbers the Studs and Conchos are SC.



Colored Studs can be ordered. We substitute the color stud for the chrome stud and use the same pattern of studs. We have noted the actual color in the description of the bags. We do mail sample of colored options out for free. This bag shows Pink Crystal Studs.



Rear Pockets can be added to the back of most of the bags. It provides extra storage for the small items that you want to easily access. They open and close with a turn fastener, which is a metal twist knob that comes through a grommet on the pocket flap. In our alphabet soup of part number the rear Pockets are P.



Fringe is the cut leather strips that are commonly seen on the bottom edge of the lid. Our standard fringe is 5" in length. In our alphabet soup of part numbers the Fringe is F.



Colored Piping is the color of the welting used in a variety of places on the bags. The picture above shows orange piping. The standard color is black, we have a large number of choices. We do mail swatches for free. There is no part number for the colored piping, it is noted as a separate remark in the part number.

Locks are available to add protection to the goods inside. The pad lock function is a small prong coming through a grommet on the lid of the bag, the pad lock is not included. In our alphabet soup of part numbers the pad lock function is LK.



We also have key locks available that will work on most bags with the box top lids. It does not work on the flap bags because the flap covers the locking face. In our alphabet soup of part numbers key locks are LK2.



An inside view of the key lock. The ratchet bar is spring loaded and fed into the small locking device which extends inside the bag about  $\frac{3}{4}$ ".



Hand braid is a triple weave done around the bottom edge of the lid. It replaces the piping on the bottom of the lid and gives the bag a finished look. In our alphabet soup of part number the hand braid is BR.



On our split lid bags the hand braid covers more than the bottom edge of the bag. This also shows the standard basket weave on this type of bag.



Basket Weave is 5-8 rows of a hand stamp weave. On bags with the long straps it covers the area between the slits for the straps where the nickel sit. On bags with short straps it starts at the nickel and goes down. In our alphabet soup part numbers basket weave is BW.



Hand Carving is done by an artist who carves and tools the leather with a design. He does not add color so the carving is the color of the leather. Long words cannot be accommodated. A picture must be submitted.



A gun holster can be sewn into one of the saddlebags. We will need to know which bag and which way you want the butt of the gun facing, toward the front of the motorcycle or toward the back. In our alphabet soup of part numbers the gun holster is GH.
